Dear Mr. Haller,

Dream Valley Farm started growing Aloe Vera in hydroponics beds in 1982. We maintain approximately 50,000 square feet of greenhouses that are designed exclusively to produce Aloe.

We conducted a comparison experiment with MicroSoil in Aloe beds and a test plot in 5 gallon containers in potting soil. Plants were grown 4 months, which is our average growing time before harvest. We achieved positive results. An overall 35% increase in size and weight was noted in treated plants.

This letter is to inform you of our findings.
